LOOKING BACK...

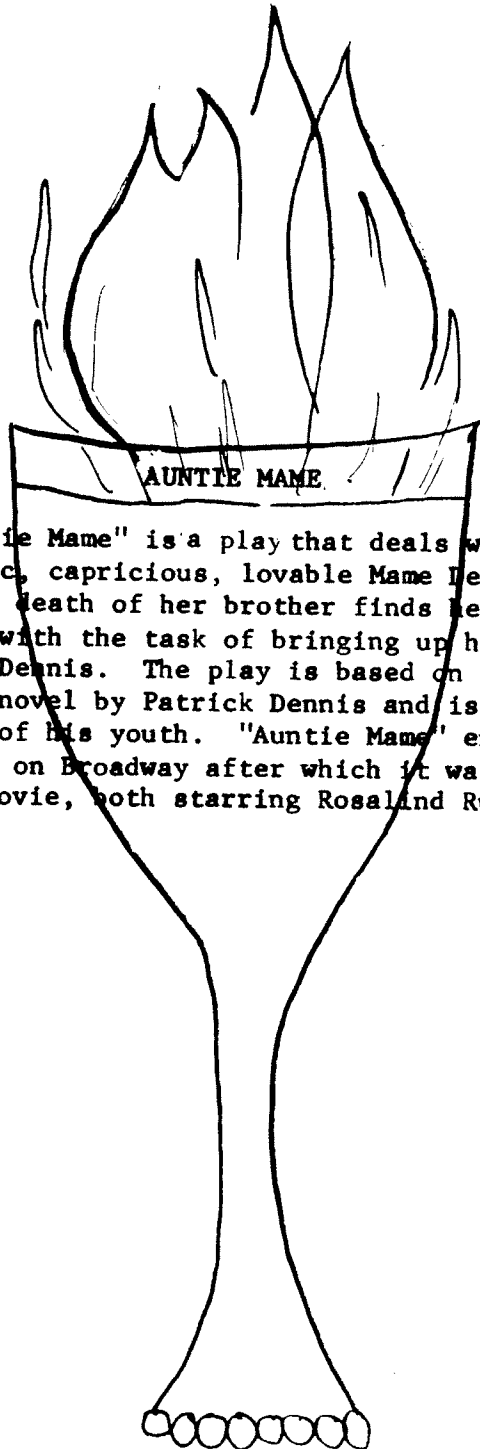
Recognizing the need for a strong dramatic group at Carey, to facilitate the productions of plays and musicals and to train students in this field, the Carey Thespian Guild was organized in January, 1963. It is open to all students in the Senior High School who are interested in our goals-to learn more about all phases of drama and to continue to produce quality productions for the students at Carey.

The Guild is organized under an apprentice system devised by the National Thespian Guild. All prospective members earn points and learn production methods either as actors or technicians. When a student earns ten points he becomes a full-fledged Thespian.

By working under this system, members of our Guild become eligible for membership in the National Thespian Guild, a nationwide honorary dramatics group numbering over 444,000 members in high schools all over the United States and Canada. As of this year, Troupe 152 of the National Thespian Guild was established at Carey. To achieve continuity for our members will continue to be our aim. We will assist the music department in their spring production and hold our annual initiation banquet in May. We thank all the students, parents and friends for their presence, and we hope for their continued support.

WHO'S WHO

JUDITH JABLON AS AUNTIE MAME * Although this is not Judi's first appearance on Carey's stage, it is the first role that actually fits her personality. Her previous parts include "The Mouse That Roared," and a philosophizing drunk in "Jr. Capers," as well as her daily performance in Carey's halls, for which she receives no Thespian Guild credit. She is Recording Secretary of our Thespian Guild Troupe 152. Besides other extra-curricular activities, Judi maintains a B average. She intends to go to college and will most likely average as a healer or one of the world's great educators.

BILL LONG AS PATRICK DENNIS AS A BOY * Anyone who has spent any time in Carey will be familiar with Billy. Though he appeared in last year's "Jr. Capers," this is his first really dramatic role. His warm personality and carefree, boyish ways make him a perfect choice for young Pat. Active in a number of areas in school, you might remember him for his performance in the wrestling meets or in a variety of other activities.

STEVE COOPER AS PATRICK DENNIS * Steve, who plays the older Patrick, is staging a comeback on the stage since his retirement after his debut as Morley in "The Christmas Carol" in 1962. His future plans are, to quote "Auntie Mame", to "Live, live, live!"

DONNA LAHEM AS VERA CHARLES * In her Junior year, Donna danced in our musical, "Carousel", due to her twelve years of dancing school, and a part in the "Mouse That Roared" Aside from her dramatic interests, Donna was co-captain of the Freshman Cheerleaders and a member of the J.V. Squad. She is also an active member of our secretarial club and participates in Senior Service Squad. After graduation she would like to put her skills to work and become a professional dancer.

JOE MC CULLOUGH AS LINDSAY * Joe was on the Carey stage in a dramatic production for the first time last year. Everyone who saw "The Mouse That Roared" will remember Joe's performance as Chet Beston. His work on the production of the plays and musicals has earned him membership in the National Thespian Guild. Last year Joe was elected President of the Student Council and was inducted into the National Honor Society. His appearance in "Auntie Mame" as Lindsay should provide us with a truly enjoyable performance.

JOAN SCHIFFMAN AS AGNES GOOCH * Joan made her debut on Carey's stage as Abigail Williams, one of the female leads in "The Crucible." Since then she has performed in "Blood Wedding," "The Young and Fair," and "Stage Door," appearing at Gateway Dramatic Workshop, Bellport, Long Island. President and former secretary of the Thespian Guild, director of Jr. Capers, Member of National Honor Society, Senior High Choir, Senior Hall Squad, Senior Board and Piano are also part of her accomplishments.

ROSEMARIE BAIALARDO AS NORAH MULDOON* She came to Carey in the 8th grade and has been very active in Student Government. She is currently Vice-President of the Senior Class and captain of the Senior Hall Squad. She has worked on previous plays as a member of the National Thespian Guild, but this is her first appearance on the stage. She has enjoyed working with the cast, and she has participated actively in the production of "Auntie Mame."

FRANK CHRISTIANO AS ITO* Frank is a new talent for Carey's stage. In ninth grade he was historian of his class and did a fine job. An active member of Thespian Guild all through his senior high years has helped him achieve a major role in "Auntie Mame."

DON BREEDEN AS BRIAN O'BANNION * Don is most often seen around school with his camera, working in the capacity of photographer for our yearbook, "The Log." Having never been on stage before, he will let his personality substitute for experience in the character of Brian O'Bannion.

STEVE REISERT AS BEAU * The spirit of a Southern gentleman is personified in a portrayal of Beauregard Jackson Pickett Byrnside by Steve. Steve is the Long Island vice-president of the C.Y.O. His acting career began on the day he was born; he cried before the doctor even touched him. He enjoys all the styles of dancing and has trouble remaining immobile. All these talents have been combined for the success of the Senior Class Play.

GEORGE QUINTERO AS MR. BABCOCK * George is a well-known person in Carey. He has been an active member of the Student Government, Senior Board, National Honor Society, and the Senior High Choir. George made his first appearance on the Carey stage in Junior Capers and now plays Mr. Babcock, the conservative businessman, in "Auntie Mame."

NANCI SCHUBACH, ONE OF THE STUDENT DIRECTORS of the Senior Class Play, has a great deal of dramatic directing experience. She first appeared on the Carey stage last year in a bit part and student director of "The Mouse That Roared." Though earlier attempts at acting proved only moderately successful, his leadership qualities and generally belligerent character made him more suited for directing. His interests are widely diversified and he is known for activities in many areas, including Student Government, Carey Clipper and a number of less athletic pursuits. His future plans include: college, marriage, and possibly death.

BILL GARBE, STAGE MANAGER * Those who are familiar with "Carousel" will remember Bill as the set designer for that wonderful production. "The Mouse That Roared" is also among the other Thesopian productions he has participated in. He plans to attend Pratt Institute in the fall and obtain his Masters degree in art education. He plays the guitar and banjo and is on the art staff of the Clipper and Log. He is also an active member in the Senior Art Pallettes.

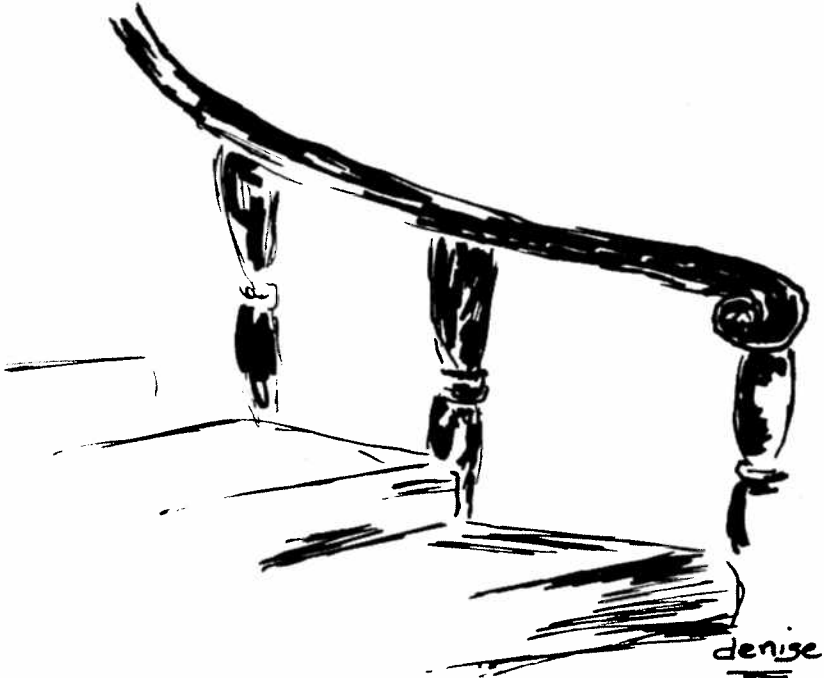
